DFW Airport

Fort Worth is conveniently located just 17.5 miles from Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport. With more than 1,900 flights daily, DFW Airport serves as a gateway for destinations across the country and around the globe.

The close proximity of Fort Worth's three districts makes the city's convention center, hotels, attractions, and restaurants easily accessible for visitors. The fact they are located within a three-mile radius of one another, coupled with beautiful scenery, a friendly atmosphere and safety, makes Fort Worth the ideal destination.

Driving Directions from DFW Airport to Downtown. Take the South exit from DFW International Airport to Highway 183 West to Fort Worth. Highway 183 will turn into Highway 121; follow the signs to Downtown Fort Worth.

Rental Car Facility. DFW International Airport's Rental Car Facility is just south of the Airport's south toll plazas. This facility consolidates all present and future rental car companies into one location. From your airline terminal, you will be able to catch the Rental Car bus and be taken directly to the facility.

Molly the Trolley offers free step-on transportation throughout the downtown area. The Free Zone is bounded by Commerce, Main, and Houston Streets. Molly runs approximately every 15 minutes.

Route 1 - Historic Stockyards - Northbound (city bus)
\$1.50 fare each way

Transportation from ITC and downtown to the Stockyards Historical District. Runs every 15 minutes Monday - Saturday and every hour on Sunday.

Route 2 - Camp Bowie/Museums (city bus)
\$1.50 fare each way

Transportation from ITC and Sundance Square to the museums on Camp Bowie and Ridgmar Mall. Runs every 15 minutes Monday - Friday, every 30 minutes on Saturday, and every hour on Sunday.

Route 7 - Cultural Districts/Zoo (city bus)
\$1.50 fare each way

Transportation from ITC and downtown to the Cultural District, museums, and zoo. Runs every 30 minutes Monday - Saturday and every hour on Sunday.

Route 15 - Historic Stockyards (green trolley)
Saturday Service Only

\$1.50 fare each way

Transportation from ITC, Sundance Square, and downtown to the Historic Stockyards Visitor Center. Runs every 30 minutes.
